IV. <u>OLD BUSINESS</u>

A. Project Status Updates - Operations Manager Murray

1. <u>Motorola Premier1 CAD Suite</u> – Cut-over date for CAD and Mobile begins on Tuesday, November 4th with Lincolnway and the Sheriff's Office, Wednesday, November 5th with Joliet and Eastcom, and Thursday, November 6th with Wescom and Romeoville. Records Go Live will happen in early 2015. Final T/C Training will be held throughout October.

2. <u>County Radio Project</u> – The RFP for the County Radio System has been released.

3. <u>Texting to 9-1-1</u> – Our applications have been submitted and we are awaiting further notice on timelines. Intrado has informed us that the one-time fee for Web-based 9-1-1 Texting for our System will be \$930.00 for the four (4) PSAPs.

Administrator Figved will be meeting with the regional ETSBs to have a regional campaign regarding Texting to 9-1-1 in the future. It is thought that perhaps a soft roll-out announcing; texting is available county-wide for Senior, Handicapped and Hard of Hearing Individuals. Followed in two weeks by texting is available of all school and college campuses in the county. And then Texting is now available to all residents of the county would be a deployment plan over a six-week period.

4. <u>ICC Financial Reporting for ETSB's</u> – Staff was able to complete the mandated ICC audit for FY2012 and 2013. The deadline for submission was October 1^{st} and we were finished and submitted a week before that date. We had tremendous cooperation and help from the County Finance Department; Karen Hennessy and Emily Perkins who were much more familiar with auditing standards and the County's CAFR. On October 2^{nd} it appeared that about 25% of the State ETSB's had not yet filed their

reports. The next meeting of the Illinois 9-1-1 Advisory Board will be on Tuesday, October 14th. They plan to discuss the financial audit reports.

5. <u>Bolingbrook PSAP Merger with Wescom</u> – The consolidation of the Bolingbrook PSAP with Wescom has been approved. Final arrangements are being made with an expected cut-over date of Monday, November 3rd or earlier if possible. The F&E Committee will discuss the requested "buy-in" fee for Wescom in the amount of \$93,779.06.
