## VIII. <u>NEW BUSINESS</u>

A. **USDD Additional Licensing**. Additional licensing is needed on the PSAP USDD servers to handle the XML interface from the 9-1-1 equipment upgrades previously authorized by the Board. The plan is for 9-1-1 to purchase the licensing on behalf of the PSAPs to keep the project moving forward, and this would be covered by their FY21 Surcharge Reallocation Grants. Staff recommends approval.

#### **RESOLUTION #09242020-02**

<u>MOTION</u>: To approve the purchase of additional licensing for LCC and WESCOM USDD Servers from US Digital Designs in the amount of \$38,250.

B. **ESRI Additional Licensing**. After thorough analysis of options and criteria for the information sharing project, the ESRI solution has been identified as the best choice of the options studied. Adding these tools will give 9-1-1 the ability to implement the information sharing project, but also the tools to build robust and updated dashboards to meet other needs including the increased request for such information exchange from surrounding 9-1-1 systems. This builds on our currently existing ESRI architecture. Staff recommends approval.
